RULES OF PLAY

The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews

LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)

- a. a ball is out of bounds if it is
- a. Over any boundary fence or hedge or
- b. Beyond any line of white stakes

2. WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)

- a. Water hazards are defined by yellow stakes
- b. Lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes

3. STONES IN BUNKERS

are movable obstructions (rule 24-1)

4. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2)

- a. All tarmac paths (including adjacent drainage ditches)
- b. Stone Tee and Directional information plaques
- c. All irrigation pipes

5. STAKED TREES

are immovable obstructions and relief MUST be taken in accordance with Rule 24-2

6. FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS

all fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if such an obstruction on or within two club lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief without penalty as follows: If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which

- a. is not nearer the hole
- b. avoids such intervention and
- c. is not in a hazard or on a putting green
